Guidelines for the Jorge Paulo Lemann Fellowship Academic Year 2024-2025

The Jorge Paulo Lemann Fellowships support graduate students who are residents and citizens of Brazil who are committed to becoming leaders in their field and making a difference in Brazil in a career dedicated to creating social impact in the country. The fellowships are made possible by the generosity of Jorge Paulo Lemann.

Applicants must be planning to enroll in full-time, in-residence degree programs which run during the regular academic year at one of Harvard's graduate or professional schools, with a preference for, but not limited to, the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health, the Harvard Graduate School of Education, or the Harvard Kennedy School. Students applying to part-time, summer-only, or on-line programs are not eligible for consideration.

Applicants must apply for this fellowship prior to enrolling at Harvard University. Students who are currently enrolled at Harvard are not eligible to apply. Candidates should apply for consideration before entering the U.S. and prior to the start of their Harvard programs. Candidates must apply to and be accepted to an academic program at the university independently from this fellowship application. Candidates do not need to know their admissions status in order to apply for this award. Admission to the University does not guarantee a fellowship award.

Fellowships are awarded for up to two years in a degree program. Candidates are evaluated on the basis of merit and financial need.

Recipients are expected to return to Brazil to contribute to the country following the completion of their degree program.

The online application requires the following materials:

- Application form.
- Resume or Curriculum Vitae.
- Statement of Purpose.
 - *In a short essay, not to exceed 1,000 words, please discuss your plan of study at Harvard University and how it relates to your career goals.*

The deadline to submit the online application and all supplemental materials is **March 1, 2024**. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.
